



Drive-in Cinema 2023 FAQ

Can I bring food and drink?

Yes, you're welcome to bring food and drink but we will also have hot food and drink available on the day.

What do I need to bring?

Please don't forget to bring your e-ticket which has been emailed to you.

How do I hear the film?

You can use your own car stereo to tune into the film. We will let you know what FM frequency to tune into. You can also bring a portable radio(s) if you'd rather.

How do I find the venue?

If you are using a satnav to get to the venue, put in the postcode PO39 0JD and follow signposts for The Needles on all major routes, including the A3054 via Yarmouth, the B3401 and B3399 via Freshwater and the A3055 via Freshwater Bay. Will I be allocated a specific parking space?

Spaces will be allocated firstly by size of vehicle, then by first-come, first-served.

Will I be able to park next to my friend's car?

If you want to park with your friend's car you must arrive together and have a similar sized vehicle. If you or your friend's vehicle is a different size, or you arrive separately, you may be parked separately.

What time should I arrive?

Gates open 30 minutes prior to the film starting. We encourage you to allow enough time to grab some food, but if you arrive any earlier you may be asked to wait.

What happens when I arrive?

After presenting your e-ticket, you will be asked to wait in the holding area. You will be invited to queue in a particular line depending on the size of your vehicle. Each line will then be asked to follow directions to their allocated space. Vehicles will be positioned depending on size to provide an optimal viewing position for all.

What happens if it rains?

The event will go ahead in most weather conditions, as long as there is no risk to the audience. If a screening has to be cancelled for any reason, we will announce this on our social media channels as soon as possible.

How big is the screen and will I still be able to see if it's daylight?

The LED screen is 9.2m x 5.3m and because the screen is LED and not projected, the picture will be of high quality at all times of the day and night.

Are dogs allowed?

Well-behaved dogs are permitted, but you may be asked to leave if your pet disturbs others.

Are there toilet facilities?

Yes, there are toilets on-site.



Can I change my booking?

Unfortunately, changes cannot be made once a booking is confirmed. Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Will you use subtitles?

No.

Can children come?

Children are welcome, but film certifications must be adhered to so please ensure your child is a suitable age for the film you're attending.

Can you watch the film outside your car?

No, the films must be watched from the comfort of your car.

Please note, it is illegal to make visual or audio recordings of the film.
