Paragliding 2024 FAQs



- 1. Why is there no date on the event page? You can choose your own date to fly. For safety reasons, the weather conditions must be perfect for flying, so Albatross Paragliding can only provisionally book you onto a date. You will find out the evening before the event if the event will be going ahead. If the weather conditions worsen overnight or in the morning, they might reschedule with limited notice.
- 2. Can I contact you for weather updates or questions about the event? We are selling places on behalf of the activity provider for a cheaper price than booking with them directly. Once you have purchased a ticket from us, we will direct you to Albatross Paragliding to book your provisional date and ask any questions you may have. You are more than welcome to contact us at fundraising@wessexcancer.org.uk with any fundraising queries.
- **3. Can I record my flight?** You are not able to hold any devices whilst flying. Albatross Paragliding can record your flight via their GoPro camera and edit it into a professional video; you can purchase this video from us for only £30! All funds raised go towards providing emotional support and wellbeing services for local people affected by a cancer diagnosis.
